1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present:

11. No action taken at this time on implementing a burn ban ordinance.


12. No action taken on the budget.


13. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to approve the financial statement. Commissioner Supak seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
